

A curved line surrounding a center point, every point of the line being an equal distance from the center point.

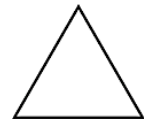
