

**THE GOBLIN IN THE HOUSE.**

**Directions.** Print out. Play the game to the music of "The Farmer In The Dell." Form a circle with the goblin inside the circle. The song is sung by all and the child who plays the goblin chooses a child from the outer circle to join him/her inside the circle. Then, it's the next child's turn until the end. Use as many verses as are children or if there is a large group, divide it in half and give the other half its turn later.

**The goblin in the house, the goblin in the house,**

**Hi ho its Halloween, the goblin in the house.**

**The goblin calls a witch, the goblin calls a witch,**

**Hi ho its Halloween, the goblin calls a witch.**

**Other verses:**

The witch calls a cat ... The cat calls a bat ... The bat calls a skeleton ...  
The skeleton calls a pumpkin ... The pumpkin calls werewolf ... the  
werewolf calls an owl ... the owl calls a ghoul ... the ghoul calls a warlock  
... (mouse, gargoyle, rat, spider, scorpion, snake, etc.) ending with the  
warlock (or some other thing) calls a ghost ... (see below).

**Ending:**

**The ghost scares us all, the ghost scares us all,**

**Hi ho its Halloween, the ghost scares us all.**

(The child playing the ghost chases all the children around the room and the game can be repeated.)
